

Informative document regarding the transport of an injectable medication

The injectable medication **palopegteriparatide**, used in the treatment of severe hypoparathyroidism, must be stored at a constant temperature of 4°C (unopened pen) or at room temperature (pen in use). This medication must under no circumstances be frozen, as this may result in a loss of its therapeutic efficacy.

The injectable medication **teriparatide**, used in the treatment of severe hypoparathyroidism, must be stored at a constant temperature of 4°C. This medication must under no circumstances be frozen or exposed to room temperature, as this may result in a loss of its therapeutic efficacy.

It is essential that the patient keeps their injectable treatment within immediate reach at all times, in order to be able to administer an injection if necessary.

The international transport (by plane, by train, etc.) of the (palopeg)teriparatide pen and the materials required for its injection does not present any specific risk.
